

CONTEXT AND QUESTION

ANALYSIS FRAMEWORK


- The dairy shed

ARCHETYPAL SITUATION 1: THE PERMANENCE OF THE GLOBALIZATION



- Generic products / agribusiness system / intensive production systems / export
 - Material and organizational conditions allowing the emerging and the development of the dairy shed (\emptyset cognitive resource)

- Strong support of public policies



agribusiness and top-down development



ARCHETYPAL SITUATION 2: THE PERMANENCE OF THE TERRITORIALIZATION

- Specific products / local supply chain (intra-shed demand)



- High diversity of territorial resources mobilized: material, organizational and cognitive

ARCHETYPAL SITUATION 3: CO-EXISTENCE OF GLOBALIZATION AND TERRITORIALIZATION



- Spatial co-presence and/or temporal succession and/or hybridation
- High diversity of material, organizational, cognitive territorial resources
- Co-existence supported by public policies, collective action (role of leaders), local governance


